NURSERY FEES

Please could we politely ask parents/carers to ensure that nursery fees are paid on time. We are finding that an increasing number of parents/carers are paying nursery fees extremely late. As part of the payment contract it states that late charges will be implemented if payment is late. All parents/carers that make payment via Bank Transfer please could we kindly ask to state your child's initial as the payment reference.

TERM DATES

October Half Term

All funded children break up on Friday 17th December 2021 and return back to Nursery on Monday 10th January 2022. (3 weeks)
Nursery is also be closed on 27th 28th December 2021 and 3rd January 2022.

WHAT'S HAPPENING IN NURSERY
